Dual Credit Information

If your student signed up for one or more dual credit courses next year, there are several steps they need to complete to ensure they are properly enrolled in the course.

1. Online application.. This can be done at www.bhc.edu
2. Registration: BHC has registration forms (copies are in the counseling office) that need to be signed by students and parents. They then need to be returned to the counseling office.
3. Take the Accuplacer test if you are enrolled in English Composition. This is given in May at UT and is Black Hawk's entrance exam. Scores of 80 on the Reading and a 5 on the Writing tests are required. Retakes are offered at \$15 per test. An SAT score of 510 on the Read/Write portion also meets the class requirement. A copy of the score is needed for BHC.

All three of the above steps must be completed for enrollment in a dual credit course. Registration will not be final until the end of the school year. Payment for fall classes will be due around mid September to Black Hawk College. Failure to pay or register properly could result in either no credit from BHC or full tuition required for credit. No Child Left Behind and Highly Qualified Teachers

Federal legislation requires us to notify our community, parents and students of the qualifications of our teaching and para-professional staff. The legislation requires that we have only "highly qualified" staff in place by 2006. The legislation clearly sets forth the standards that define "highly qualified". In short, it means that teachers are certified in the specific areas they are teaching and that paraprofessionals have at least sixty (60) credit hours of college work. A list of our current staff is available for review in our administration center.
